

Anthony J. Hornfeck Service Award

Established: 1979

Description: To recognize outstanding, meritorious services to the IEEE Industrial Electronics Society.

Administration: IES Awards & Honors (A&H) Committee.

Eligibility: Must be a member of IES.

Prize: US\$4,000 and certificate, plus reimbursement for IES-approved travel expenses to receive the award, up to but not more than US\$3,000.

Funding: IEEE Industrial Electronics Society.

Presentation: At the Society's major international conference.

Other notes: This is the Industrial Electronics Society's chief service award. It was first presented in 1979 as Meritorius Service Award.

Operational details:

Nominee solicitation: Calls for nominations are announced in the IEEE Industrial Electronics Magazine and the society's website. Nominations must be submitted using the nomination form:

Deadlines: Nominations may be submitted at any time, but

only those received by April 1 will be considered for judging in the same year. Nominations received after April 1 will be considered for the next year.

Judging criteria: For exceptional service to the Industrial Electronics Society. More than one award may be given. Awarded only when a suitable candidate is identified. The award is not necessarily awarded yearly.

Award recommendation: IES A&H Committee will review nomination materials. The recommended award recipient will be the result of the Committee vote. A&H Committee will present a recommendation to IES AdCom for final approval at the summer AdCom meeting.

Publicity: The award winner(s) will be publicized in the IEEE Industrial Electronics Magazine and on the IEEE Industrial Electronics Society website.
